## Division Basics

## (Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication)

$\qquad$ class:

I will tell you the other way of division.

For example,
$24 \div 6=4$
$\begin{aligned} & 6 \\ & 1\end{aligned}{ }_{2}+6+3=6=24$


Here, we need to add 6+6+6+6, which equals to 24 . That means, 4 times adding 6 gives you 24.

One more example,
$24 \div 8=3$
$8+8+8=24$
Here, we need to add $8+8+8$, which equals to 24 . so, 3 times adding 8 gives you 24.
