## Use the clues to find the missing cards.

## MRLPFUL EXANMPLE

$3 \square 4 \square$

If you calculate the mean for the first four numbers you will get $3+4+6+7=20$, and 20 divided 4 equals 5 .

The clue tell us the new number will increase the mean by 2 which will change the mean to 7 .

The unknown card will increase the mean by 2 .

All you need to do is multiply the new mean by the total number of cards, $7 \times 5=35$.

How can we change 20 to 35 ? The card must equal 15.
