

# THE DISTRIBUTIVE PROPERTY OF MULTIPLICATION

# ANSWERS

THE DISTRIBUTIVE PROPERTY OF MULTIPLICATION ALLOWS US TO DISTRIBUTE OR GIVE MULTIPLICATION TO ADDITION OR SUBTRACTION. IT MAKES NUMBERS EASIER TO WORK WITH AND ALLOWS US TO BREAK VARIABLES AND NUMBERS INTO PARTS.

## HELPFUL EXAMPLE

$4 \times 72$   $\Rightarrow$   $4 \times 72 = 4 \times (70 + 2)$

$4 \times (70 + 2)$   $\Rightarrow$   $(4 \times 70) + (4 \times 2)$   $\Rightarrow$   $(280) + (8) = 288$

$4 \times 72$  CAN BE CHANGED TO  $4 \times (70 + 2)$ , BECAUSE  $72 = (70 + 2)$ .

BY CHANGING THE 72 TO  $(70 + 2)$  WE CAN SOLVE THIS PROBLEM IN OUR HEAD.

USING THE DISTRIBUTIVE PROPERTY WE CAN SEPARATE THE 70 AND 2 AND MULTIPLY.

SEE HOW WE DISTRIBUTE THE 4 TO THE 70 AND 2?

NOW THE MULTIPLICATION IS EASIER AND CAN BE DONE IN OUR HEAD.  $280 + 8 = 288$ , SO  $4 \times 72 = 288$ .

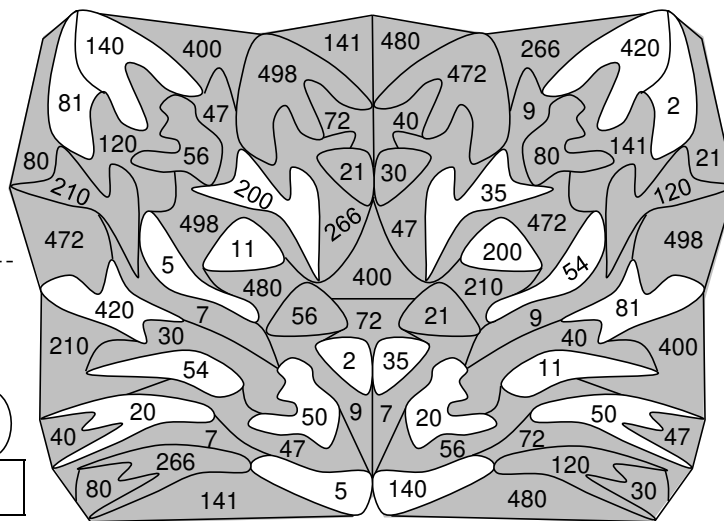
